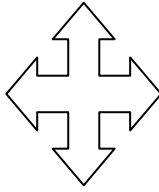

Frequently Asked Questions!

Who can go?

A. Youth who are entering freshmen through graduated seniors in high school. Adult advisors must be 21 years old by July 20, 2010. We will need chaperones to go with us! Let Marian Bauer know of your willingness to help.



What is the cost?

A. The cost of the Triennium itself is \$409.00 per person. There are other costs such as transportation and food along the way. There will be some help from Eastminster Presbytery. There are about 320 days (as of Sept. 1, 2009) until Triennium. Think about putting away \$1 per day...and you'll have it almost paid for! Ask your church for help and earn some yourself!

What will we do at PYT 2010?

A. Participate in worship, small groups, times of recreation, service projects, live and eat together! Build relationships that last a life-time. You will explore what being a Christian means "For Such a Time as This." There also will be times for a college fair, exhibit hall displays, residence hall meetings and denominational celebrations.

What do I need to do to get registered for PYT? (as a group from a church/or as an individual youth)

A. Marian Bauer, the DCE at Canfield Presbyterian Church is the Registrar for Eastminster Presbytery.

- The **first deadline for the national group is November 1, 2009 so Marian Bauer needs to know that you are interested in going before that date!**
- When the delegation for Eastminster Presbytery is set, we will get together two times before PYT. We will meet as a delegation during the event and report back to Eastminster Presbytery and its individual churches after PYT.
